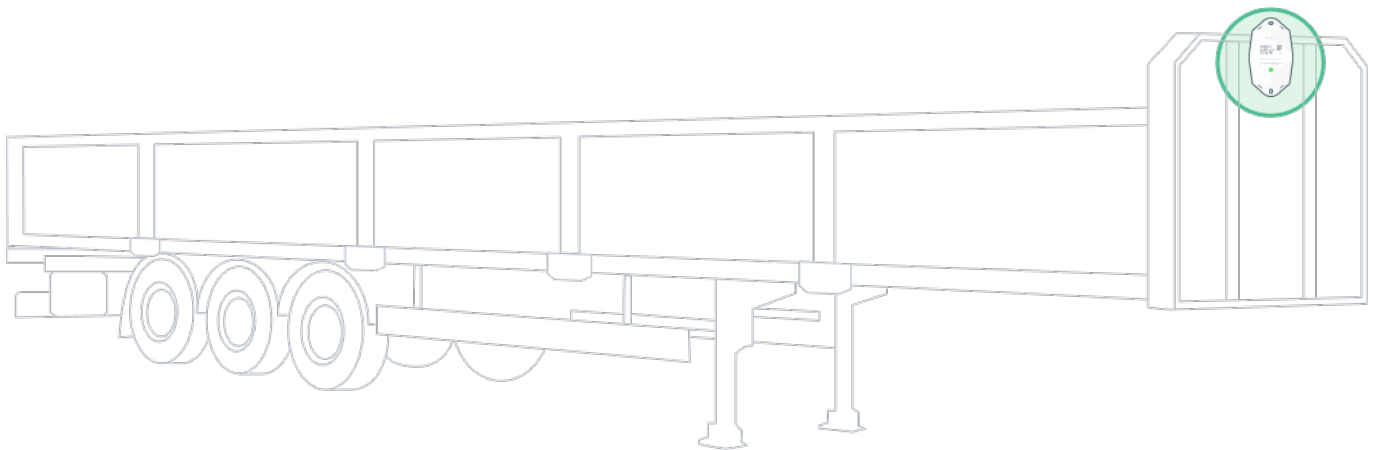


Trailers can come in a variety of shapes and sizes.

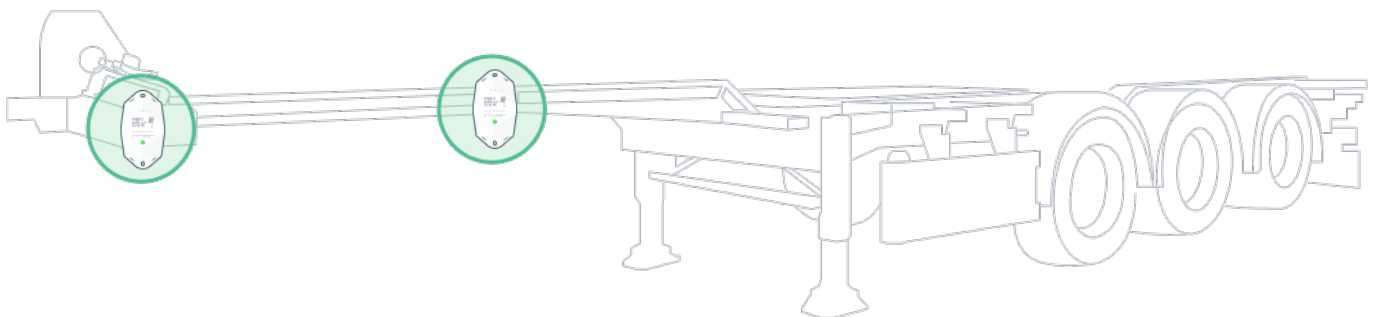
 <p>Make sure the tracker is not fully surrounded by metal parts, as this blocks the signal.</p>	 <p>Protect the tracker by using the cooler unit's shape if possible.</p>	 <p>Place the tracker as high as possible on the asset.</p>	 <p>Ensure the tracker has a clear view of the sky.</p>

Do's	Don'ts
Install the tracker as high as possible	Not on moving parts or close to the wheels
Vertical installation if possible	
On the front of the trailer	Under the chassis (bad signal)
Clear view on the sky	On the very outside where the tracker might get hit by other equipment

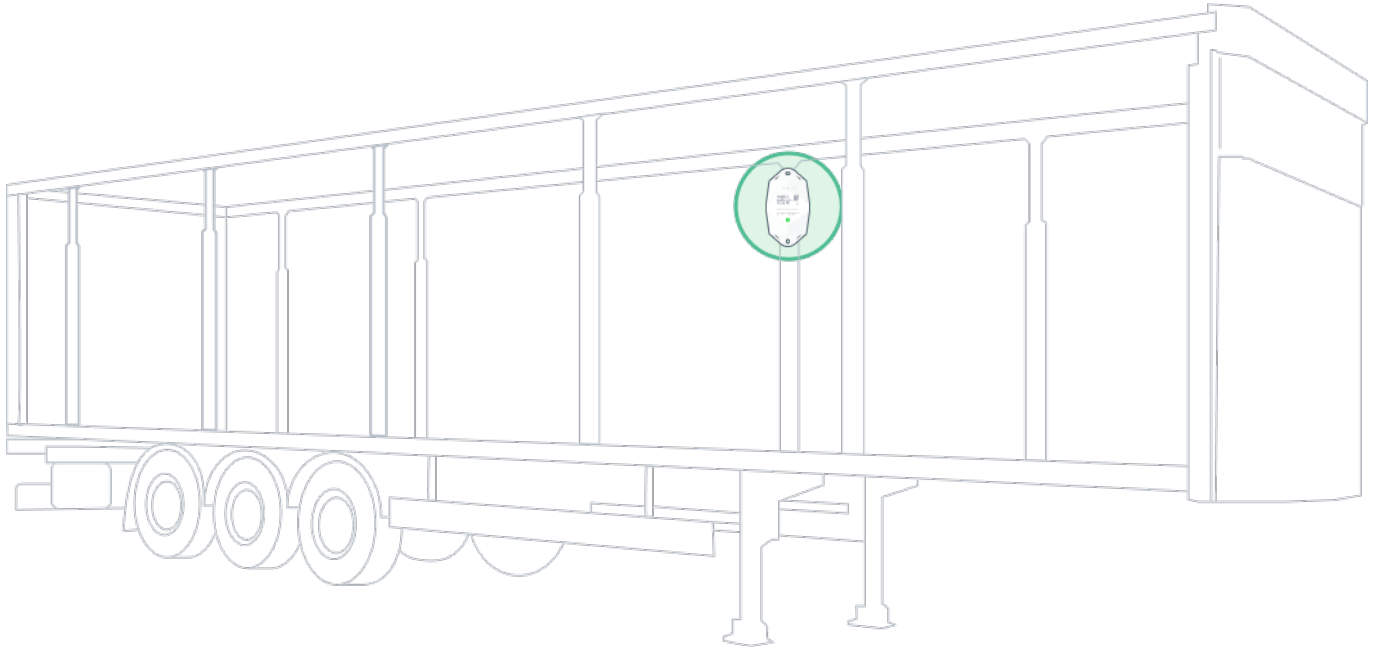
Open trailers
